Our Museum also boasts over 200 volunteers on its books, many whom give countless hours and experience freely to the museum from restoring the vehicles, firearms, and militaria, to servicing the buildings and utilities, manning the Museum's static section, and running displays, as well as off-site requirements. The volunteer body is made up of people from all across Southern Ontario, with backgrounds as varied as Mechanics, Master Electricians, Veterans, Store Clerks, Cleaners, and the list goes on.

By joining our Museum, you are making a commitment to make sure history is preserved, shared, and not forgotten. Not every volunteer can give the same amount of time and experiences and that is our strength. Your first step in becoming a volunteer is by completing this application form and letting us know a bit about you and your experience. Once this form is completed, the Volunteer Coordinator will conduct an interview either in-person or via telephone, your skills will be recorded, and a date set for you to conduct a safety brief and familiarisation of the Museum grounds and emergency procedures. It should be noted that this application does not guarantee membership.

If successful, and as part of your induction, you will be required to make a tax-deductible donation of at least \$60 prior to receiving your Member's Handbook, Passbook, and identification. This is an annual donation that will be needed in full your first year, however subsequent year payments can be spread out over the year. All volunteers are expected to read and understand the requirements laid out in the Member's Handbook, including, but not limited to the Code of Conduct, Museum Dress Standards, Required Courses, and Minimum Probationary Hours.
